



### Cosy guest for Aga's ex

When a woman is in the middle of a high-profile divorce, it is always useful to have a man to lean on - especially if he is your brother.

This week the Begum Inaara, the estranged wife of the fabulously wealthy Aga Khan, made a rare public outing to join her brother Joachim Thyssen at the opening of Vapiano, an Italian restaurant in London's Great Portland Street.

The German-born Begum, who lives in Surrey, separated from the Aga four years ago after six years of marriage. The former Princess Gabriele zu Leiningen is the Aga's second wife and 26 years his junior.

His first marriage, to former model Sally Croker-Poole, also ended in divorce.

The Aga has engaged Prince Charles's divorce lawyer Fiona Shackleton while the Begum is represented by Maggie Rae, a friend of Cherie Blair, who helped secure Princess Diana's £17million settlement.
